Your quilt block

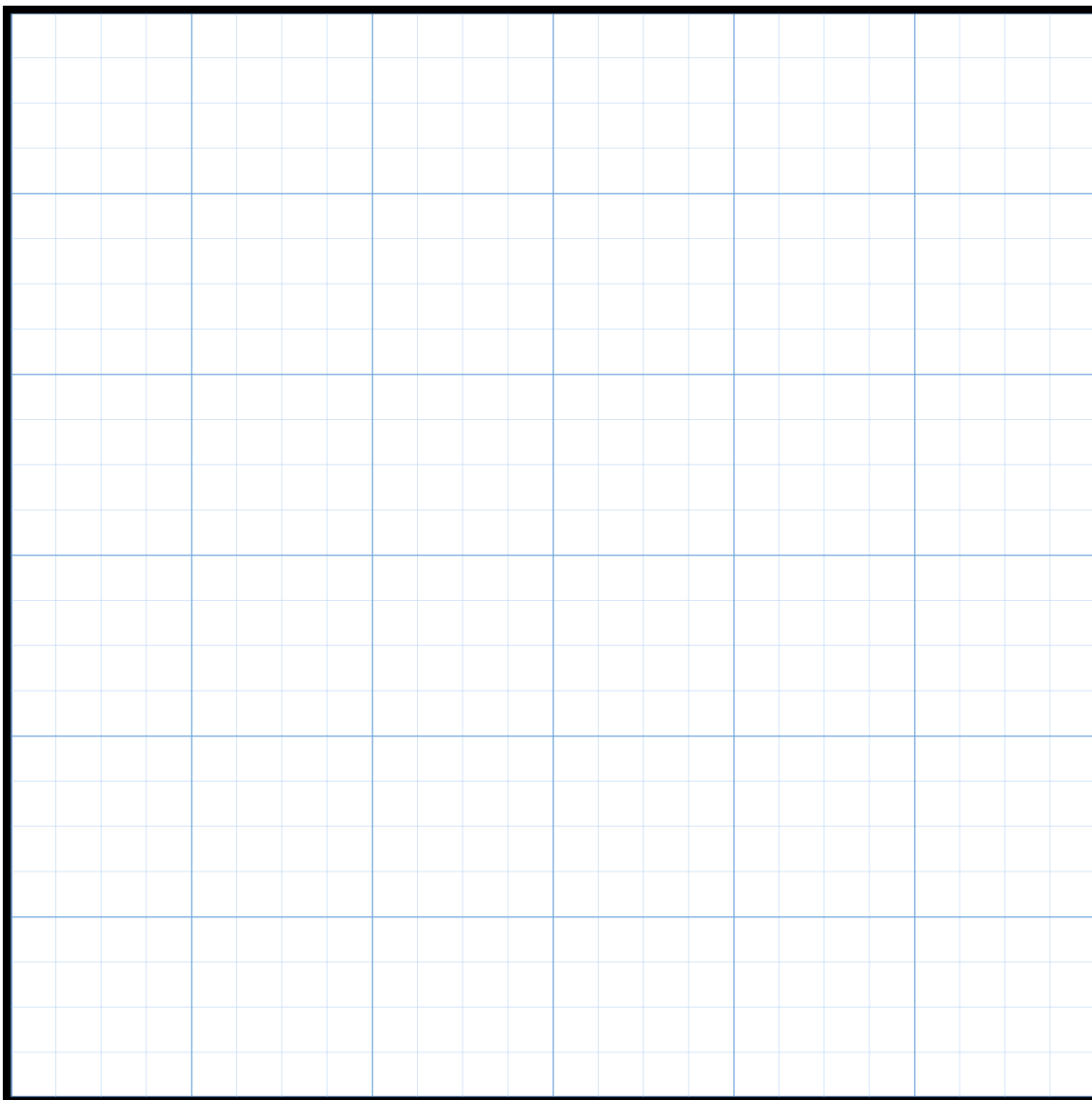
